WILL FORMS	GENERAL CONDITIONS	ADAPTIVE RULES RE : COVID-19
HOLOGRAPH WILL	<ul> <li>Written entirely by the will-maker;</li> <li>Signed by the will-maker;</li> <li>Probated by the Superior Court or a Notary.</li> </ul>	• N/A.
WILL IN THE PRESENCE OF WITNESSES	<ul> <li>Written by the will-maker or a third person;</li> <li>Signed by the will-maker;</li> <li>In the presence of two witnesses (18+ y/o) who are not beneficiaries under the Will or have not prepared the Will;</li> <li>Lawyers will falls in that category, but they add the advantage to be registered;</li> <li>Probated by the Superior Court or a Notary.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>No formal change to legal requirements;</li> <li>May be signed using « technological means »;</li> <li>Recommended to consult a lawyer to ensure that the process and the technology being used comply with the legal formalities;</li> <li>Signature proof may be a challenge with respect to the will verification process that may occur several years later.</li> </ul>
NOTARIAL WILL	<ul> <li>Prepared by a Notary;</li> <li>Signed by the will-maker in the presence of the Notary and another witness;</li> <li>Registered.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Order 2020-010 authorizes will- makers to sign a notarial will in the presence of the Notary and witness using « technological means ».</li> </ul>
