For clarity: (i) any corporation or entity owned or controlled by a municipality falls under the MASH thresholds for CFTA, and (ii) municipal government-owned entities of a commercial or industrial nature fall under the CETA Sub-Federal Other Government Entities Section A thresholds immediately above.
